

**Play Golf at
Stoke Rochford

The Management Committee of Stoke Rochford Golf Club has kindly agreed to allow delegates attending courses and conferences at Stoke Rochford Hall, who are bona fide members of a golf club elsewhere, to use their Golf Club facilities at reduced green fee rates on certain days of the week.

The Management Committee has applied certain rules and regulations which are detailed on the opposite page. If you wish to avail yourself of the Golf Club facility, please adhere to them.

Bookings must be made through the main reception at Stoke Rochford Hall where a letter of introduction will be issued to verify that you are a guest at Stoke Rochford Hall.

The entrance to the Golf Club is adjacent to and accessed via the fuel station on the northbound carriageway of the A1, immediately after the Stoke Rochford junction.

RULES FOR VISITING PLAYERS

1. A letter of introduction, verifying that the player is attending a course at Stoke Rochford Hall, must be presented to the professional.
2. Green Fees of £15.00 per person are payable to the professional at the club.
3. All players must be bona fide playing members of a Golf Club and be in possession of a current handicap certificate.
4. Concessionary rates apply on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays only. Teeing off times are between 9.30 - 11.30am and 2.00 - 4.00pm on those days.
5. Play must commence from the first tee.
6. Stoke Rochford Golf Club Rules must be adhered to at all times.

Concessionary rates are not applicable for weekends, Bank Holidays, and the day immediately following. It may be possible for you to use the golfing facilities at these times, but the full green fee of £30.00 for one round, £40.00 for two rounds will apply.

A limited selection of golf clubs is available for a hire charge of approximately £10.00. Sharing clubs from one bag is not permitted.

*Please note: During the months of November to February inclusive play on Saturday/Sunday is not permitted unless accompanied by a Stoke Rochford Golf Club member.



ETIQUETTE AND CARE OF THE COURSE



The player who has honour should be allowed to play before the opponent or marker tees his ball.

No one should stand close to or directly behind the ball, move or talk when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.

No player should play a ball until the players in front are out of range.

Players searching for a ball must indicate to the game behind to pass as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not easily be found. They should NOT search for five minutes before doing so. They should not continue to play until the game in front is out of range.

When play of the hole has been completed the players should replace the flagstick and immediately leave the putting green, marking their cards on the next tee.

Any match playing a full round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round, and a single player has no standing on the course and should give way to a match of any kind.

If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses a clear hole on the game in front it must allow the match following to pass.

In the interest of all players SLOW PLAY IS TO BE AVOIDED at all times. Care should be taken not to damage the putting green, including that caused by leaning on putters or the flagstick, placing the golf bags on the edge of the green or ball marks.

Practise swinging on the tee is not allowed.

Please place all litter, drinks, cans etc in the waste receptacles provided.

Enjoyment of the game is in everyone's interests so please try to observe the points above.
